COVID-19 Protocol for Trainers, Exhibitors, and Staff

- ◆ Wear your mask at all times unless you're riding or driving a horse—including in the barn areas!
- ◆ Everyone on the grounds for the show must wear a wristband of the appropriate color for the day. To receive your wristband, you'll receive daily health screenings, including temperature checks. Screenings will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the southeast area of the south pavilion and the north end of the west pavilion from Wednesday, September 9 through Saturday, September 12.
- ◆ Gate 3, located off of 38th St. at the east end of the south pavilion, will be the only gate open to allow move-in on Sunday, September 6 through Tuesday, September 8. On those days, all other gates will be closed, and screenings will be conducted at Gate 3 upon arrival.
- ◆ Outside spectators are not allowed. The Coliseum will be open for physically distanced seating for barn groups up to 8. Follow all signage and announcements about physical distancing.
- ◆ Handwashing and hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the fairgrounds. Use them often.
- ◆ If you have fever, cough, or shortness of breath, you must stay home.
- ◆ Most importantly, stay safe, stay healthy, and enjoy the show! We're thrilled you're here. Following all the guidelines above will help us all make sure the show can continue.
