## **OPEN DIVISION**

### American Saddlebred Horse Futurity of Indiana

#### GENERAL PROVISIONS

THE THREE	The American Saddlebred Horse Futurity of Indiana will be shown in three (3) divisions: Weanlings: Yearlings, and
THE THREE	The American Saddlebred Horse Futurity of Indiana will be shown in three (3) divisions: Weanlings: Yearlings, and

DIVISIONS Two-Year Olds.

WHAT COLT'S All colts shown must be the produce of stallions and mares that have been previously registered by the American

ARE ELIGIBLE Saddlebred Horse Association Registry.

## NOMINATION OF SIRE

HOW TO To nominate a stallion in the Futurity, it is necessary: (1) That the stallion be registered by the American NOMINATE Saddlebred Horse Association Registry and (2) that a fee of \$50.00 be paid to the Futurity on or before

THE SIRE May 1st of the year the foal is nominated.

#### **NOMINATION OF DAM**

HOW TO To nominate a mare in the Futurity, it is necessary: (1) That the mare be registered by the American Saddlebred NOMINATE Horse Association Stud Registry, and, (2) that a fee of \$20.00 be paid to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the THE DAM year in which the foal is to be eligible for the Weanling Division of the Futurity.

#### THE WEANLING DIVISION

HOW TO In order to make a foal eligible to show in the Weanling Division of the Futurity, the following conditions must be complied with: (1) The sire and dam must be nominated in the Futurity, the year in which the foal is born. MAKE A WEANLING (2) Onetime fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the year the foal is born. **ELIGIBLE** HOW SHOWN, The entries in this division shall be shown In Hand.

#### THE YEARLING DIVISION

HOW TO In order to make a colt, filly, or gelding eligible to show in the Yearling Division of the Futurity, the following conditions KEEP THE must be complied with: (1) The colt, filly, or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling Division of this Futurity YEARLING and all conditions and requirements of that Division must have been fulfilled. (2) Onetime fee of \$50.00 must be paid ELIGIBLE to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the year following the birth of the foal.

HOW SHOWN, The entries in this division shall be shown In Hand.

#### THE TWO-YEAR OLD DIVISION

HOW TO	In order to make a colt, filly, or gelding eligible to show in the Two-Year Old Division of the Futurity, the following
KEEP THE	conditions must be complied with: (1) The colt, filly, or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling and Yearling
TWO-OLD	Divisions of this Futurity and all conditions and requirements of those Divisions must have been fulfilled.
ELIGIBLE	(2) Onetime fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the year the entry becomes a two-year old.
	HOW SHOWN. The entries in this division shall be shown as a Fine Harness Class

#### PRIZES

HOW THE	In each division the winner will receive 35% of the prize fund of that division; second, 20%; third, 16%; fourth, 10%;
PRIZES ARE	fifth, 8%; sixth, 6%; seventh, 3%; eighth, 2%; ninth, \$200; and tenth, 200.
DIVIDED	The nominator of the dam of the winning foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$100.00. The nominator of the dam of

the second place foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$50.00.

The nominator of the sire of the winning foal of the Weanling Division will receive \$100.00, and the nominator of the sire of

the second place foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$50.00.

VALUE The value of the Prize Fund of the Futurity each year shall be the total amount of money paid in fees, miscellaneous funds, OF THE and added donations less 10% administrative expenses. Each year the specific awards to the nominators of the dams and PRIZE FUND sires will be deducted before the division of the Prize Fund among the three regular divisions of the Futurity. HOW PAID

The Prize Fund shall be divided equally between the Weanling, Yearling, and Two-Year Old Divisions.

#### **FEES**

WHERE TO PAY FEES: Make checks payable to the American Saddlebred Horse Open Futurity of Indiana.

LIABILITY: No entry is liable for more than the amount paid in but there will be no return of payment. The right is reserved to reject any entry, and to debar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the Futurity.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. The use of artificial appliances or devices on weanlings and yearlings such as chains, shackles, rubber bands or blindfolds is prohibited on the grounds before or during a show, Smooth, round leather straps are allowed
- 2. Blinkers hoods with half-cups mounted in the vertical position so as to allow forward vision are allowed on weanlings and yearlings on the grounds before and during a show.
- 3. Weanlings and yearlings must show with uncut, unset tails; tail sets worn on the show grounds in preparation for the show are expressly prohibited.
- 4. The use of curb bits on weanlings and yearlings is prohibited.

ANY ENTRY WITH PROHIBITED EQUIPMENT MUST BE DISQUALIFIED FROM FURTHER COMPETITION AND SHALL FORFEIT **ALL ENTRY FEES AND WINNINGS.**
